

CALL FOR MURAL PROPOSALS

RIVERWALL MURAL PROJECT

The Cambria/Somerset Public Art Committee of Bottle Works: Art on 3rd Avenue is proposing the following program for artists in the Western Pennsylvania region. Stretching from the pedestrian bridge along Roosevelt Boulevard and ending at the intersection of Third Avenue are 54 cement River Wall Barriers. Each of these barrier walls are approximately 3 1/2 feet high and 25 feet wide. We are proposing that individual artists, art classes, and community organizations be solicited to submit designs for murals to paint on these walls. Upon completion this would create a colorful series of images acting as a visual gateway into the Cambria City Cultural District.

Participating Artists will be required to provide a fully developed color example of the proposed design. This will allow the Committee members to work with the participating artists as to placement of the design, content, and to make suggestions to help create most professional design. This design should be to scale to aid with the enlarging of the final mural.

The designs submitted must be proportioned to fit a 3.5 x 25 foot space.

Each design will be considered within the context of the artists' style. Both objective and non objective designs are eligible for consideration. Abstract Imagery, Patterned Imagery, Historical and other Narrative Imagery are all acceptable. Imagery showing Political Messages, Images involving Commercial Branding, and any imagery determined to be demeaning of any ethnic or religious group or people will be rejected by the committee.

The Cambria Somerset Public Arts will assume responsibility for the preparation of the surfaces to be painted and will supply the paint for this project.

It is anticipated that this project will take up to two years to complete We will continue to accept submissions until the available spaces are filled.

Upon acceptance of their design the artist will receive a painting schedule, a contract form, and a billing form. These will need to be completed and returned to the Cambria Somerset Public Arts Project before any work can begin.

Each artist will have a 40 day period to complete their design.

All selected artists will be paid an amount of \$300. per completed mural. Artists may submit more than one design for consideration, or a larger design involving more than one panel.

The completed murals will be considered shared intellectual property between the individual artists and the Cambria Somerset Public Arts Project/Bottle Works Arts on Third Avenue and may be reproduced for the purposes of publicity, and solicitation through means of mechanical reproduction.

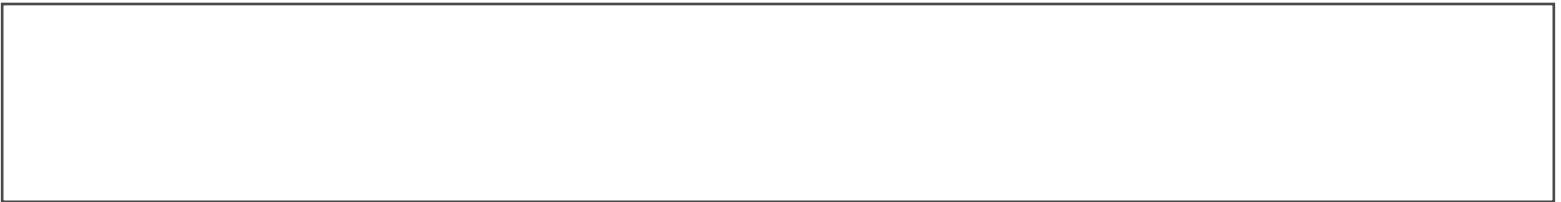
