The 3rd Avenue Folk & Arts Fest is the first summer festival in Cambria City highlighting the artistic talent of our region! With the addition of the brand new pavilion on our campus, the music will all take place under the pavilion, allowing a lot more room for us to set up art vendors! The festival will feature live music from some of the area's hottest acts, juried artisan booths, live art demonstrations, food & beer, Italian Street Painting, and art exhibits!

Several 10' x 10' (outdoor) spaces are being made available to Artists, Craftspeople, Exhibitors and Non-Profit Organizations. Spaces are limited. All vendors must apply and be approved by Bottle Works' festival committee. As an art vendor, we are asking that you demonstrate your artistic process while selling your art. Note: participating artists may not sell food, drink, or anything other than their own original art.

- You must be at least 18 years old to apply.
- Work must be the original work of the artist submitting the entry & not derived from copying of another's art or from kits.
- Please submit 3 to 5 digital photos of your work. Must be a jpeg file, minimum 300 dpi
- Once approved, the vendor fee is non-refundable regardless of reason of requested cancellation by



vendor.

- Festival is rain or shine.
- Set-up will be Saturday July 20 from 8:30 – 10 AM.
- Alcoholic beverages, music, and smoking are not allowed in vendor booths.
- ADA compatible cord/cable covers required for all foot traffic areas. Vendors must provide any required materials and are mandated to abide by all ADA requirements.
- We ask that all vendors promote their participation at the festival via social media prior to and during the festival.

LIABILITY: BOTTLE WORKS, volunteers, or the City of Johnstown assumes no liabilities against physical harm, loss, theft, or damage to artwork and other belongings for the duration of the festival. Therefore, necessary arrangements must be made by the vendor.
