Hello Vendors!

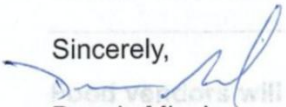
The Venue of Merging Arts (VOMA) and Bottle Works Ethnic Arts Center (Bottle Works) invite arts, other non-food vendors, and non-profit organizations to participate in the Ethnic Fest Block Party on Chestnut & Third Avenue, part of the long-standing Cambria City Ethnic Festival. This annual three-day festival draws several thousand guests to the region to enjoy live music as well as a diverse selection of food and beverages. This is a wonderful opportunity for local vendors to gain exposure in our community!

The festival dates for this year are Friday, September 4th, Saturday, the 5th, and Sunday, the 6th.

We are offering a limited number of 10'x10' spaces along Third Avenue and Chestnut Street to arts and non-food vendors as well as non-profit organizations at the rate of **\$50 for the entire three-day weekend** or **\$35 per individual day**.

All vendors must be approved in order to exhibit and/or sell at the Cambria City Ethnic Festival, and **advance registration and payment are required**.

Please note: This vendor agreement is for arts, crafts, clothing, and other non-consumable goods. Participating vendors may not sell any food or beverage items under this agreement. This is a family-friendly event, so please keep that in mind when selecting your items. Festival management has the right to forbid sales of any items deemed inappropriate. Offensive merchandise is strictly forbidden.

BOOTH INFO

- Size: 10' x 10' (provide your own table, chair, backdrop, sides, roof, etc.)
- Tents, tables, chairs, and lighting are the vendor's responsibility.
- If you would like to remain vending after dark, we recommend using battery-powered camping lights. We cannot guarantee access to electric power for non-food vendors. All vendors using electric outlets are required to supply their own GFCI safety devices, agree to assume liability for and indemnify Bottle Works, VOMA, and/or residents that may provide electricity, Cambria City Ethnic Festival, their volunteers, and the City of Johnstown of any liability with respect to accidents or incidents resulting from the vendor's electrical use. Vendors may remain no later than 11:00 pm Friday & Saturday or 7 pm Sunday.

BASIC VENDOR INFORMATION

- All applications will be reviewed for vendor selection before approval. Approved vendors will receive a call/e-mail with set-up information and booth number/location.
- Vendor fee must be included with your application to be considered. Once approved, the vendor fee is non-refundable (unless the festival is canceled in response to federal, state, or local government requirements). If not approved, the fee will be returned.
- Alcoholic beverages, loud music, lewd language, and smoking are not allowed in vendor booths.
- We ask that vendors complete an exit survey to help us evaluate the overall success of the event and aid in future event planning.
- Festival is rain or shine. No refunds will be issued due to weather.
- We ask that all vendors promote their participation at Ethnic Festival via social media before and during the festival.
- Only handcrafted/original or unique art and products are permitted.
- Access to electricity is not provided unless reserved & approved in advance and will be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ADA-compatible cord/cable covers are required for all foot traffic areas. Vendors must provide any required materials and are mandated to abide by all ADA requirements.

SET-UP and TEAR DOWN

- Setting up may begin:
 - **Friday, September 4th:** Prior to 4 pm. All vehicles are required to be off the street by 3:30 pm.
 - **Saturday, September 5th and Sunday, September 6th. 6th** Prior to 11 am. All vehicles are required to be off the street by 11:00 am. The festival begins at noon.
- Tear-down starts at dusk each day and should be completed no later than 11:30 pm. Items left overnight are NOT the responsibility of Bottle Works, VOMA, or the Cambria City Ethnic Festival.

LIABILITY: Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Bottle Works, VOMA, Cambria City Ethnic Festival, volunteers, and the City of Johnstown, from and against all loss, claims, damage, claim of damage, expense or cost, including attorney's fees, which arises out of, or is related to, or is in any way connected with vendor's participation in the Cambria City Ethnic Festival - Ethnic Fest Block Party on Chestnut and Third Ave. This indemnification shall apply to any acts of omission, willful misconduct, or negligent conduct, whether active or passive, on the part of the vendor or anyone employed by or working for the vendor.
